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In order to have a smooth start to the school year, please make appointments before August. Immunizations can be obtained at the Vermilion County Health Department. It is not too early to begin scheduling immunizations now.

Requirements by grade level are as follows:

Preschool Students

- Complete Immunization Record/ **(4) DTaP, (3) Polio, (4) Hib, (3) Hep B, (1) MMR, (1) Chickenpox, and (4) Pneumococcal**

Kindergarten Students

- Complete Immunization Record/ **(5) DTaP, (4) Polio, (4) Hib, (3) Hep B, (2) MMR, (2) Chickenpox, and (4) Pneumococcal**

Sixth Grade Students

- Complete Immunization Record/ **(1) Tdap, (3) Hep B, (2) MMR, (2) Chickenpox, and (1) Meningitis**

Ninth Grade Students

- Complete Immunization Record/ **(1) Tdap, (2) Chickenpox, and (1) Meningitis**

Seventh – Twelfth Grade Students

- **Twelfth Grade Students/ (2) Meningitis NEW 2015-2016 – 2nd dose must be after their 16th birthday**
- **7th – 11th Grade Students/ (1) Tdap, (1) Meningitis, (2) chickenpox**

Immunizations are by appointment only.

Parent or Legal Guardian must bring child to appointment and sign consent forms.

You must bring current shot record, and insurance cards.

Payments accepted: Cash, Check or Credit Card if you do not have insurance.
