### Vital Records

- ❖ Birth and Death Records

### WIC

- ❖ Available to children up to age 5 and also women who are pregnant and/or breastfeeding.

### Annual Adult Seasonal Influenza

- ❖ Annual flu vaccination clinics for adults.

### Communicable Disease Control

- ❖ Investigates disease outbreaks and prevents the spread of disease to the people of the community. Tuberculosis testing and treatment/follow-up is provided as well.

### Immunizations

- ❖ Provides all required and most recommended to infants, children, and adults.

### Lead Poisoning Prevention

- ❖ Home inspection and case management services
